

**Canadian Geographic Indigenous Peoples Atlas of Canada Giant Floor Map** 









Suitability: Grade K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 Social Studies, Native Studies.




Giant floor map is 35 feet by 26 feet (10.67 meters by 7.92 meters).
