### **Keynote: Sandra Herbst - Forging Equity and Hope by “Sitting Beside” Our Students (8:45am-10am)**

Assessment. Its root word – assess – comes from the Latin word ‘assedere’ which means “to sit beside”. When viewed in this way, quality assessment practices can create spaces of hope and equity!

In this dynamic keynote, Sandra Herbst will provide a Canadian perspective through accounts, anecdotes, and examples. 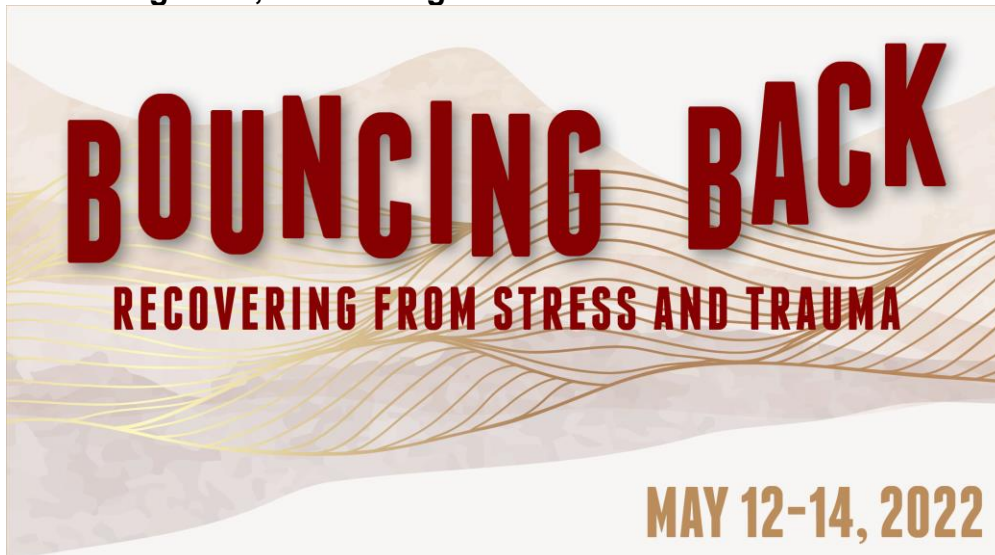


**Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women (MMIW): National Week of Action (April 29<sup>th</sup> – May 5<sup>th</sup>)**
